# Welcome New Board Members



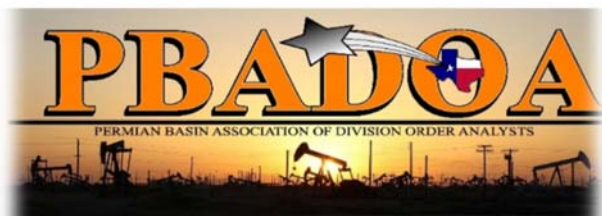

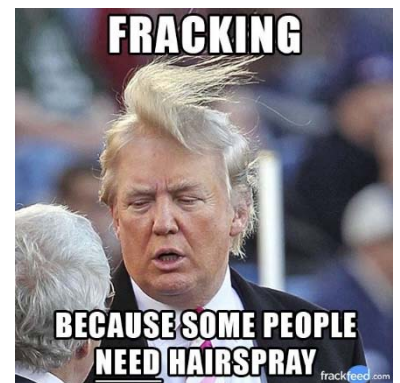
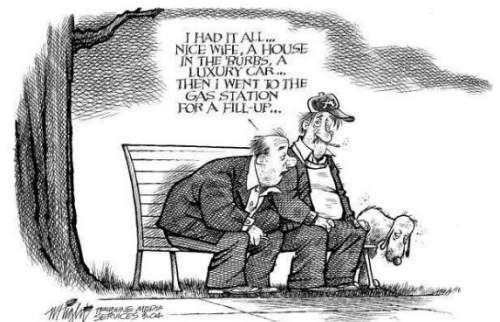
