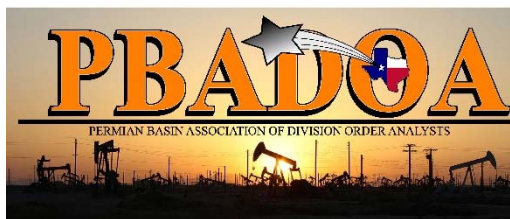

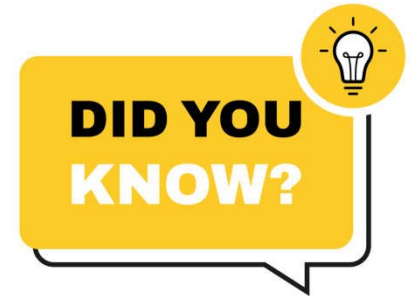


Fun Facts

... Midland, Texas ranks as the second wealthiest town in the country. High oil prices and surging production have sparked an economic boom in West Texas. The unemployment rate in Midland, located right in the heart of the Permian Basin, was 3.5% in July. In 2011, the metro area's average income was \$65,100, ranking No. 2 nationwide. For comparison, San Francisco and New York City ranked third and eighth respectively.
